1. Proposal submitters are not required to be ILCA members.
2. Submission of a proposal constitutes a commitment to present if accepted. Failure to present and register for the meeting, if not justified, will jeopardize future acceptance of proposals.
3. With the submission of a proposal, authors declare that if the proposal is accepted they will register via the ILCA conference registration site to participate in the conference.
4. Speakers will receive complimentary registration for the day they speak, in addition to US\$100 for each session presented to help defray personal expenses. This payment will be provided at conference check-in by a check (cheque) drawn on a US bank.
5. All information presented during Conference sessions will be presented in English. Proposals must be submitted in English.
6. All information presented during Conference sessions must conform to the International Code of Marketing of Breast-milk Substitutes and subsequent World Health Assembly (WHA) Resolutions.
7. Presenters will be required to disclose to the audience any real or apparent conflict(s) of interest that may have a direct bearing on the subject matter of the continuing education activity. This includes disclosures of any financial interest/arrangement or affiliation with any organizations that could be perceived as a conflict of interest in the context of their presentation subject matter.
8. Presenters are not permitted to advertise or distribute commercial materials in their session. No advertising is permitted outside the Exhibit Hall. Violators of this policy will not be invited to speak at future ILCA conferences.
9. Presenters selected for presentation will be notified of handbook guidelines and procedures.
10. Printouts of presentations and handouts will not be provided in the attendees' registration materials. The objectives and proposal of the presentation will appear in the conference handbook and all other materials pertinent to the presentation will be included on the conference CD that all registrants will receive.
